

Interested in the challenge and fun of shooting big bore, non-scoped rifles out to a distance of 400 yards?



The Green Mountain Regulators have built a long range facility which allows shooting of late 1800's period correct "buffalo" rifles in a safe and fun venue. Our long range uses a part of our facility where steel targets are placed within the natural environment at distances from 100 to 400 yards. Our steel plate targets are for lead bullets only and jacketed bullets may not be used.



A typical match consists of engaging sets of targets ranging from 100 to 400 yards. All participants take their turn while other shooters help with spotting and scoring hits. This is a fairly informal and friendly competition and an excellent way to practice shooting rifles at long distances.

Other shooting activities such as lever gun matches at 100 and 200 yards are sometimes shot after the long range match.



The long range area was designed to allow plenty of parking, plus the firing line is covered by a sun tarp to allow sound to dissipate and to aid in shading the shooter from the hot central Texas sun. Shooting tables are positioned along the firing line. We also have areas for shooting from the prone position or using shooting sticks.



As usual with the Green Mountain Regulators, the matches are relaxed and fun, fun, fun. An hour is set aside prior to each match for sighting in and fouling shots, then small, medium and large targets are engaged at each distance during the match. Your fellow shooters will be happy to give shooting tips as well as congratulations or good-natured ribbing, depending on how you do!

The Green Mountain Regulator's conduct Long Range rifle matches on the Sunday following our 4th Saturday Cowboy matches each month. Sighting-in and fouling shots are allowed from 8:00 a.m. until the start of the regular match at 9:00 a.m. In addition, we have practice days once a month, normally scheduled for the second Saturday, but check our website for updates, as practice dates are subject to change.

We are located off FM 1174 in Burnet County and are convenient to North Austin, Georgetown, Round Rock, Cedar Park, Liberty Hill, Marble Falls, Bertram, Burnet, Llano, Killeen and Copperas Cove.

From Cedar Park (about 26 miles)

Take 1431 west toward Marble Falls for about 25 miles. Turn right onto FM1174 and go 8/10 of a mile it is on the left.

From Georgetown (about 31 miles)

Take 29 west to Liberty Hill, turn left onto 1869 and go about 6 miles to FM1174. Turn left on FM1174 and go about 9 miles it is on the right.

From Marble Falls (about 12 miles)

Take FM1431 east for about 11 miles. Turn left onto FM1174 (toward Bertram) and go 8/10 of a mile it is on the left

From Liberty Hill (about 15 miles)

Take 1869 west and go about 6 miles to 1174. Turn left on FM1174 and go about 9 miles it is on the right.

From Bertram (about 15 miles)

Take FM1174 South for about 15 miles it is on the right.
